DISTRICT/WLF HEARING AID REPORT January 25, 2009

Thanks to the 20 District Lions Club who have donated to our ongoing District Hearing Fund!! To date this Lions Year, we've received \$3,044 from Clubs to continue this fine project. We'll need every \$ as our District 27-D1 applications received and approvals granted are more numerous than any prior year. In addition to these donations, fourteen District Clubs have committed to help with the WLF negotiated \$200 Audiology Fee per hearing aid for individuals approved. We've approved eleven of the twenty-three requests for aids during the past five months, and denied twelve applicants who were (mostly) over the required household income limit. A more detailed report will be available for Zone Chairs to be distributed to each Club at Zone Meetings. Thank you to the Zone Chairs for your help in promoting our hearing aid project!
