

MISSION TO MEXICO REPORT

January 25, 2009

At the time of the last cabinet meeting John Roundy of Monroe and Glen Spring of Albany along with their wives were involved in a Mission to Victoria Mexico. A caravan consisting of a bus, an ambulance, a pickup truck and the Mission to Mexico trailer loaded with supplies for needy Mexican people left Beloit on October 19th.

20 boxes of school and cosmetic supplies were dropped at a girl's orphanage in Reynoso, Mexico. In all about 2250 people were served in this four day mission.

As we write this report about 40 Wisconsin Lions are conducting an eye Mission near Vera Cruz, Mexico. On February 5th the third Mission will be held at Camargo, Mexico. This is a city of about 25,000 near Rio Grande City, TX. The 4th mission will be on February 18th.

Because the success of these missions depends on a good supply of used eye glasses from our Lions eye glass recycling center we encourage all clubs in their efforts to collect them.
