PediaVision Screener:

Prevent Blindness America has recently approved another method of screening children 3-5 years of age. It includes the screener, laptop computer, printer, screening software and cables. It takes a single picture of the eyes over a 1.5 second exposure and can detect near-sightedness (*myopia*), far-sightedness (*hyperopia*), unequal refractive power (*anisometropia*), blurred vision, eye structure problem (*astigmatism*), pupil size deviations (*anisocoria*), and gaze deviations (*strabismus*.) Upon completion of the screening the software will indicate Pass/Fail/Retry readings. The system provides a printed copy of the results for parents and eye care specialists and can track a child's progress over several years of screenings. The device is manufactured in Germany and is available through PediaVision to charitable organizations at a cost of \$9300 (+any on-site training desired.)

Vision Screening Results:

The results are given for those clubs that have informed me of completed screening numbers for the '09-'10 year. I know there are many clubs that are doing screenings. All it takes is an e-mail with the club name and numbers to be included in the district report.
