# **District Cabinet Meeting Report Children's Vision Screening**

### **Digital Camera & Computer:**

New pricing and an optional model have just been announced for the PlusoptiX digital screening camera system. The price of the camera has dropped from \$8500 to \$5875 for 2013. With a tradein of a used screener the price is reduced another \$1000 making a camera price \$4875 plus another approximately \$300 for a printer and case to carry supplies.

## **Training Session in the district**:

We have a PlusoptiX training session on Saturday, January 12, 2013 in New Glarus. As of this report 41 Lions from 11 different Lions Clubs have signed up to attend. Lioness Sue and I travelled to Monroe Lions Club on October 22, 2012 to demonstrate and explain the workings of the PlusoptiX camera system.

### **PlusoptiX Screenings:**

The screening reports have begun to arrive. The clubs below have reported their numbers to me and I have included them in this report. Area clubs have scheduled the camera quite extensively for the months of January, February, and March. Waunakee, Mt. Horeb, Token Creek, New Glarus, Belleville (by New Glarus), and Monticello Lions will be moving the camera between their clubs during that period.
