

WISCONSIN LIONS MISSIONS REPORT

Twenty seven Wisconsin Lions just completed an eyeglass mission in Grenada, Nicaragua. With the help of two area Lions clubs 2750 people were fitted with eye glasses. Grenada is a beautiful old city of 200,000 inhabitants. Nicaragua is the second poorest country in this hemisphere so the need there is great. Glasses for the mission were shipped with supplies for the Wisconsin Nicaragua Partners.

This was the only Wisconsin Lions mission scheduled for this year. Another mission is being planned for next February or March in another city. More missions will be conducted once more relationships are established with other groups in the country. There is the possibility of a mission in the Yucatan peninsula of Mexico however security will be the deciding factor.

In February two trailers filled with medical and school supplies and a firetruck were driven to McAllen, Texas where they were turned over to the cities of Reynosa and Camargo.. Two thirds of one trailer was filled with items from District 27-D1.

The Wisconsin Lions Missions annual meeting will be held on Sunday August 11 at the Albany Lions Clubhouse.
