

GLT Notes for District Cabinet Meeting

Communicate like a Leader:

We need to send several people from our District. Dick Schwedrsky is attending. I recommend we send some Zone Chairpeople or some Club people who we would like to get involved in the District. Ask the cabinet and Zone Chairs for recommendations. Bring up the seminar at all Zone Meetings and publicize that it provides skills and abilities that help in many walks of life.

Identifying & Mentoring Future Leaders:

All of us in the cabinet and Zones need to look at Lions that we meet and work with for future leader prospects. Who in our clubs are active leaders, or have shown the ability or interest in leading. Who takes initiatives? Who are natural leaders, or who are trying but need help in honing their leadership abilities. Each one of us need to continuously and actively look for Lions with this potential, and work and mentor them to become our future leaders. If you do not feel like the appropriate person to mentor, then tell another leader and ask them to become the mentor. We need to make sure all potential future leaders have at least one mentor working with them to help them grow and support our District and Association.

Monday April 24 in Waunakee (Regions 2 & 3), Tuesday April 22 in Dodgeville or Belmont (which ever the Zones want)(Region 4), and Thursday April 24 in Albany (Region 1).
