

Restoring Hope Transplant House Capital Campaign

The Restoring Hope Transplant House Capital Campaign is a \$1.3 million campaign that will expand the House to a 16 bedroom facility.

Wisconsin Lions have been committed to the success of corneal tissue transplant since 1953. Then in 2010, we expanded our scope to promoting all transplants through a partnership with Donate Life Wisconsin and their Wisconsin Donor Registry.

This project has been approved by the Wisconsin Lions Council of Governors.

Now it's time for us to again expand our support for the ***people of our communities***' who need life saving organ and bone marrow transplants by supporting the Restoring Hope Transplant House.

Restoring Hope provides a home away from home for patients and caregivers as they go through the long and difficult transplant process.

The goal is for Wisconsin Lions and Lioness is to raise \$300,000 towards this Capital Campaign over the next three years. That breaks down to each of Wisconsin's 10 Districts raising \$10,000 a year in 2013-14, 2014-15 and 2015-16. The remainder of the funds will come from individual and corporate donations and a grant from the Lions Clubs International Foundation.
