Lions International Youth Exchange Report Distinct 27-D1 Cabinet Meeting – August 2nd, 2015

Current:

- District 27-D1 Sponsored 4 outgoing youth, each receiving a \$1000 District scholarship. Our district YE's are <u>currently</u> in: German, Italy, Estonia and Australia.
- 2. Our District hosted 6 youth out of 62 kids from 25 countries. Countries hosted in our district include Germany, Austria, Italy, Mexico, Spain & Israel. Two of the 6 youth are international volunteer counselors who were former campers at our Wisconsin Lions International Youth Exchange Camp.
- Our youth camp is scheduled from July 19th July 26th at Camp Vista near Campbellsport WI. . Along with the 62 youth from 25 countries, we have 16 volunteer counselors (including 4 that have become LIONS since participating in our program) and 10 mostly Lion and Lioness staff volunteers.

<u>Fundraising</u>: We are currently soliciting funds from our district Lions and Lioness clubs to finance this year's program. These funds are used to administer this program which involves paying our districts' share of the Youth Exchange camp-related fees, youth exchange scholarships & host family stipends. All the funds collected are used only for direct youth exchange related costs. There are no indirect fees; every person involved in this program is a volunteer including the camp counselors. Our scholarship deadline is December 15th; so if possible, please make your donations early so we can allocate scholarships accordingly.

Finances/Budget:

Currently, I do not have any financial information for this report (at the time this report was submitted) as the district treasure is in the process of finalizing last year's activities before moving forward into this LION year,
