Training Sessions: A training session for the PlusoptiX screeners was held in Dodgeville on 11/9/2016. A second will be held at the District Convention on Friday afternoon at the Marriott in Middleton. More than 70 Lions and Lioness have participated during this past year. More clubs are getting involved and expanding their involvement in the program.

Result Reporting: The current reporting process has been changed by WLF, the state vision screening committee, and Prevent Blindness. All District Clubs are to report results to the District Children's Vision Screening Chair. The District Chair in turn will report to WLF and WLF staff have been given access to the PBW database to post those numbers to it. At this time there is not a need for individual clubs to report to PBW. If that changes, clubs will be notified. Please follow the request in reporting screening numbers to the District Chair as these numbers help PBW funding for training and screening activities as well as justification for WLF grant monies.

Compiled Reported District Screenings as of 1/14/17: Keep up the good work in reporting. All results are compiled for each club that have reported to me. Many have performed multiple screenings and for different ages. Those have all been individually reported to WLF and broken down by ages as reported.
