The audit of the financial records of District 27-D1 for the period July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016 was completed on July 17, 2016. The results were forwarded to Immediate Past District Governor Richard Schwedrsky, District Governor Eric Holthaus, First Vice District Governor Jodi Burmester, Second Vice District Governor John Elvekrog, and Cabinet Treasurer Bill Severson.

The Audit was conducted as a review of the financial records by sampling various charges and tracing them through the supporting detail to the bank statements. The audit did not review every transaction for the year, but was designed to give a level of comfort that the process of recording the transactions was appropriate.
