District Cabinet Meeting Report Children's Vision Screening

Training sessions for the PlusoptiX screeners were held in Dodgeville on 11/9/2016 and at the District Convention on Friday afternoon, 03/10/2017 at the Marriott in Middleton. Twenty-nine clubs, about half the clubs in the District, reported screening 10924 children. That is an increase of 2530 over the report of 8394 in 2015-16.

CVS District Chair, Dave Hineline, and CVS Cabinet Member, Lee Kuska attended a Train-the-Trainer session in Wales on June 17, 2017. The session was presented by Tami Johnson from Plusoptix and arranged by WLF. It was intended to give attendees a background to help and train other Lions to use the Plusoptix equipment.

Goals: To increase the number of children screened in the District and implement a standard screening report to be used by all clubs in reporting to the District and WLF.
