All 58 Clubs got in their Monthly Membership Reports for the first 5 months of this Lions year 2017-2018. Were missing 1 Club in December 2018

Clubs reported Activities in the MyLCI system at a rate of 91% in July and 98% in August, had all 58 clubs report activities in September, October and November. Excellent job the first 5 months. Had a let down in December as only 53 clubs reported Activities in the month of December. I can't believe that the 5 clubs that didn't report activities didn't have a meeting or any other functions in the month but failed to report them in the month.

I am seeing a number of clubs that are reporting the club meeting as an activity, as well as donations to different organizations, which it is great to have in your activities. However, I have also seen a drop off in reporting Service Activity's on the reports. By this I mean Service Activities that involve the community (Shared meal with senior citizens, working on parks, clean up on the roadside, etc.) The service projects with the community work toward you Centennial Service Challenge as well as Club Excellence Award.

I am attaching the District Monthly Membership Reporting and Activity reporting so you can see where your club stands.

As of December 31, 2017, we have 13 out of 58 clubs that have completed all 5 of the Centennial Service Challenge areas. Last year we had 49 of the 58 clubs complete all 4 of the service areas, so there is a little work to be done in the last half of this Lions year.

Don't forget that Diabetes has been added a fifth Centennial Activity.

Keep up the good work and thanks for all your work last year.
