The audit of the financial records of District 27-D1 for the period July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018 was completed on July 27, 2018. The results were forwarded to Immediate Past District Governor Jodi Burmester, District Governor John Elvekrog, First Vice District Governor Conrad Dreyer, Second Vice District Governor Tammy Rockenbach, and Cabinet Treasurer Bill Severson.

The Audit was conducted as a review of the financial records by sampling various charges and tracing them through the supporting detail to the bank statements.
