## Global Service Team Report 27-D1 Cabinet Meeting - January 20, 2019

Club Service Goals were set for 2018-2019

- 1. Complete a service project in each of the 5 Focus Areas
- 2. Complete one new service project
- 3. Increase Diabetes service projects each club 1 more than last year
- 4. Raise the visibility of service projects
- 5. Continue a high level of reporting on MyLCI

I gave a presentation on the Club Service Goals at each of the 6 Region meetings in October and distributed a Diabetes service project idea handout to all attendees.

Wisconsin Lions Diabetes Service Challenge update: As on December 31, 2018, 23 clubs have done 47 Diabetes service projects as we look to increase the 77 projects completed in 2017-18.

In reviewing the District progress, I noticed that across the board, the number of service projects reported through the first 6 months of this year is down significantly from last year. After a closed look, the totals for year over year reports are not comparable as the 2018-19 reports only include the 5 Focus Areas and Other category where the 2017-18 report included meetings, fundraisers, donations, trainings, etc.

Through December 48 of 58 clubs have completed a service project in at least 1 of the 5 Focus Areas, with 1 club completing all 5 and 8 clubs completing 4. Several clubs have reported doing a new service project.

At the beginning of January, I sent a Service update to Club Presidents, Secretaries and Zone Chairs. I also included a list of Childhood Cancer project ideas.
