The Lions Youth Exchange Committee has accepted <u>6 applications</u> for the Lions International Youth Camp & Exchange Program 2019. Four of the six participants were selected for our District Youth Exchange Scholarship (deadline for scholarship applications 12-15-2018). Our District Scholarship application includes 3 letters of recommendation and the completion of 3 short essays. Consideration is also given <u>ANY</u> applicant as long as they have a <u>sponsoring Lions club</u>. The scholarship amount for 2018/19 is \$700 per individual. The remaining two youth did not qualify this year, as both have received a district scholarship in a previous year (only one scholarship/individual) and are participating for a second time.
