The Lions Youth Exchange Committee has accepted **7 applications** for the Lions International Youth Camp & Exchange Program 2019/20. All participants applying for **International Camps** (6 of the 7 youth) were selected for our District Youth Exchange Scholarship (deadline for scholarship applications was 12-15-2019). One youth\* applied to participate in our own Wisconsin Lions International Youth Camp, Camp Vista, where there are no fees for our campers; all costs are covered by the generous donations of Lion and Lioness clubs throughout our State. Our District Scholarship application includes 3 letters of recommendation and the completion of 3 short essays. Consideration is also given to **ANY** applicant as long as they have a **sponsoring Lions club**. The scholarship amount for 2019/20 is \$600.
