Fundraising The Youth Exchange committee came to the realization that our program would probably not be able to move forward with a 2021 program in early November 2020 because of ongoing covid-19 concerns so we posted a district wide email via the club president/secretary list servers explaining the situation and asked clubs to redirect their earmarked Youth Exchange contributions for more urgent needs this year.
