As previously reported, ALL 2020/21 Summer Lions International Youth Camp & Exchange Programs have been canceled due to the current pandemic/corona virus situation. This decision was not mandated by Lions International. Each country and camp made their own decisions based on local government mandates, local trends, and predictions based on estimates through health care and infectious disease experts. In Wisconsin, the State Youth Exchange committee determined that canceling our summer program was the safest approach and reached that conclusion again this year during our January committee meeting. We are hopeful our program will resume for the 2021/22 season and anticipate recruiting Wisconsin youth to participate this upcoming fall.
