

- We are excited to report that Stacey Bullock, Senior Laboratory Technician, has completed training
 for Descemet Stripping Endothelial Keratoplasty (DSEK) of corneal tissue and the automated version
 of the type of processing known as DSAEK. After nine months of training, she is officially ready to
 prepare tissue independently for our surgeons, requesting this type of cornea processing before
 surgery.

The video will provide more information about the opportunity to become a donor and is scheduled to debut later this year.
