
# Ronald McDonald Pull Tab Program

# Little things mean a lot...

Saving pull tabs is easy! They're compact with a high concentration of recyclable aluminum.

Each year, we receive nearly \$10,000 from recycling little aluminum tabs for the Ronald McDonald House in Madison. Revenue from recycling these little bits of aluminum helps keep families close to their children who are undergoing medical treatment in the Madison area.

# How you can help:

Spread the word to your family, friends, classmates and co-workers and provide containers for them to collect pop tabs. We can provide up to 10 small pull-tab collection Houses at no charge. Each additional House over 10 is just 50 cents. Labels and flyers are available on our website to promote your collection.

# What to do with the tabs:

- Take the pull tabs to your local recycling center and have the check made out to Ronald McDonald House Charities Madison and mail it to 2716 Marshall Court, Madison, WI 53705. In the Madison area, we have a special arrangement with Resource Solutions Corp. Just ask to have the proceeds credited to RMHC-Madison.
- Drop your tabs off at the Ronald McDonald House in Madison, any day between 9 a.m.- 8 p.m.
- Take the pull-tabs to a participating McDonald's restaurant. For a list of participating restaurants, please see the back of this sheet.

## **Pull Tab Facts**

#### Weight

- 1 pound = 1,280 tabs
- 625 pounds = 1 million tabs
  - 1 ton = 3.2 million tabs

#### Measurement

- 1 inch = 1 tab
- 1 foot = 12 tabs
- 1 yard = 36 tabs
- 1 meter = 39 tabs
- 1 kilometer = 39,370 tabs
- 1 mile = 63,360 tabs
- 16 miles = 1 million tabs

## **Common Containers**

- Gallon milk jug = 3 pounds
- $\frac{1}{2}$  gallon jug = 1.5 pounds
- 2 liter bottle = 1.75 pounds
- 1 copy paper box = 24 lbs
- Large oatmeal container = 2 lbs
- Sandwich sized Ziploc = .5 lbs
- Gallon sized Ziploc = 2.5
- 32 gallon trash can = 80 lbs

#### Fun Fact

• The pull tabs are higher quality aluminum that is more valuable by weight than the actual can. There is also more aluminum in the tab than there is in the entire can!
