## Lions International Youth Exchange Report Distinct 27-D1 Cabinet Meeting – March 13th, 2009

We are currently seeking HOST FAMILIES to participate in the International Lions Youth Exchange Program. Our district is responsible for hosting ~5 international youth of which we currently have a firm commitment for 1 so far. Hosting involves integrating an international youth (age 16-21) into your home for about 4-5 weeks (of which one week the youth spend at our international youth exchange camp in Dundee Wisconsin). Hosting usually occurs through the month of July. The applications are password protected so please contact me directly (contact info below) and I will guide you to the applications.

**New this year is a Host Family Grant Program** where participating host family can apply for a grant of up to \$200 to help absorb the costs associated with the program. Please contact me for an application if interested.

**Outgoing Youth:** The Youth Exchange Committee awarded an additional \$800 scholarship to Tracy O'Mara, a Cuba City Leo, who is being sponsored by the Cuba City Lions Club. District 27-D1 has now committed 5 \$800 YE scholarships for the 09-10 YE year. The other scholarship awards were reported in the January district 27-D1 cabinet committee report.

## Finances/Budget

So far this year (08-09), we've collected \$5086.00 directly from club donations. Our total account balance is \$10018.80 which includes carryover from previous years. Our budgeted expenses include our portion of the International Youth Exchange Camp Cost  $(1/10^{th})$  of the total costs =total divided by each lions district) \$1700, 5 - \$800 scholarships (\$4000) and possibly 5 x \$200 (\$1000) host family grants.

Total estimated cost for district 27-D1 08-09 International Youth Exchange Program = \$6700.00

Our district committee has 4 representatives: <u>Terry Miller, Gene Francis, Dave Peltier and Ben August.</u>
