 - We are currently soliciting scholarship applicants from Leo Club Members through the 27-D1 Leo Advisor bulk email address.
 - Applicants must be either a active Leo club member or a direct relative of a Lion or Lioness member and reside in district 27-D1

Fundraising We are currently soliciting funds from our district Lions and Lioness clubs for the recommended amount of \$2.00/member to finance this year's program. \$2.00/member allows us to administer this program which involves paying our districts' share of the Youth Exchange camp-related fees, youth exchange scholarships & host family stipends. All the funds collected are used only for direct youth exchange related costs. There are no indirect fees; every person involved in this program is a volunteer including the camp counselor. We have also used the 27-D1 bulk email address to solicit funds from Presidents and Secretaries.

Finances/Budget

As of October 13th 2011 we've collected donations of \$2458 from 25 district Lion and Lioness clubs and have carryover funds of \$3319 accumulated from past years.

Total Account = \$5777

Projected Expenses:

Camp fee - \$1700 (paid by each of the 10 state Lions Districts) Scholarships - $$800 \times 5 = 4000 Host family Stipends ??
