**District MD27-D1 MyLCI Administrator Report**  
**District Cabinet Meeting**  
**March 11, 2018**

All 58 Clubs filed their Monthly Membership Reports for the first seven months of this Lions year 2017-2018.

Clubs reported Activities in the MyLCI system at a rate of 90% in July, 98% in August, 100% in September, October and November, 98% in December and 97 % in January. Excellent job the first seven months. The average of filing activity reports for the seven months was 98%. Good job!

I am seeing a number of clubs that are reporting club meetings as an activity, as well as donations, both of which are great to have in your activities. However, I have seen a drop off in reporting Service Activities on the reports that involve the community (Shared meal with senior citizens, working on parks, roadside clean up, etc.). Service projects that benefit the community work towards your Centennial Service Challenge as well as Club Excellence Award.

As of January 31, 2018, we have 15 out of 58 clubs that have completed all five of the Centennial Service Challenge areas. Last year we had 49 of the 58 clubs complete all four of the service areas, so there is a little work to be done in the last half of this Lions year. Don't forget that Diabetes has been added as fifth Centennial Activity.

Keep up the good work and thanks for all you accomplished last year.
