

Report to 27-D1 Cabinet
LCIF Update

We are now four months into the second year of Campaign 100, the LCIF fundraising effort to reach a \$300 million worldwide goal to support programs for disaster relief, humanitarian aid, vision, youth, hunger, environment, childhood cancer and diabetes.

I recently attended the LCIF Strategy Session for Campaign 100. There were a number of presentations about approaches that can be used to convince Lions both individually and collectively in a Club, to donate. Past International President Joe Preston hosted the training and convincingly stated why all Lions need to support our Foundation's efforts.

Fund raising goals for Districts were modified. Our District's goal for Campaign 100 in the second year is \$109,313. Again, in presentations during Club visits, zone and regional meetings, we suggest that Clubs donate to the campaign through funds they already have collected, new fund-raisers for this purpose or through individual donations by members.

A new offering is the 100 | 100 Clubs. If a club commits to being a 100 | 100 Club, LCIF is supported by 100% of the club members donating at a minimum level of \$100 per member per year, only \$8 a month. These clubs will receive annual recognition.

I have been asked to report what grant assistance LCIF has provided to our District.
